Pursuant to Article 55, Para. 1, Item 2), Article 57, Paras 1 and 2 and Article 60, Para. 1, Item 1) of the Law on Public Procurement (Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia, No 124/12, 14/15 and 68/15; hereinafter: the Law),

THE NATIONAL EMPLOYMENT SERVICE

headquartered in Svetozara Markovića 37, 34000 Kragujevac (www.nsz.gov.rs),
in its status as a compulsory social insurance organisation,
announces the following

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in an open public procurement procedure No 52/19,
for the procurement of communication services (landline telephone, internet, data
transmission and mobile telephone services)

1. The subject of public procurement are communication services (landline telephone, internet, data transmission and mobile telephone services).

The name and code in the Common Procurement Vocabulary: 64211000 – Public telephone services, 72400000 – Internet services, 72318000 – Data transmission services and 64212000 – Mobile telephone services.

The subject of public procurement is divided in lots, so that each lot can be contracted separately, as follows:

Lot 1: Landline telephone, internet and data transmission services, and

Lot 2: Mobile telephone services.

2. The National Employment Service invites all interested bidders to submit their tenders following the contracting authority's tender documentation.

To be eligible to apply, interested bidders shall fulfil obligations and additional conditions for participation in the public procurement procedure, specified in Articles 75 and 76 of the Law and in the tender documentation. The fulfilment of conditions in Articles 75 and 76 of the Law shall be proven by submitting evidence listed in Article 77 of the Law, in line with the requirements laid down in the tender documentation.

If the bidder is headquartered in a foreign country, the documentation proving the fulfilment of conditions shall be issued by the competent authority of the country in which the bidder is seated and shall be translated into Serbian and certified by a sworn court interpreter.

All documents specified in Article 77 of the Law, serving to prove the fulfilment of conditions, may be submitted as uncertified copies.



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3. The tender documentation is available for download from the Public Procurement Portal (<http://portal.ujn.gov.rs/>) and from the website of the contracting authority (www.nsz.gov.rs / Javne nabavke).

If an interested bidder sends a written request asking for the tender documentation to be sent to them (by e-mail postal services or by fax), the Contracting Authority shall send the requested documentation to the bidder by post, fax or e-mail within two days from receiving the request.

4. The deadline for submission of tenders is April 19, 2019. until 01.00 pm.

The tenders shall be submitted in a closed sealed envelope, labelled with the text: **"Ponuda za javnu nabavku u otvorenom postupku broj 52/19, za nabavku komunikacionih usluga (usluge fiksne telefonije, interneta, prenosa podataka i mobilne telefonije)- ne otvarati"** (*Application to the Open Public Procedure No. 52/19, for procurement of communication services (landline telephone, internet, data transmission and mobile telephone services) – Do Not Open*), by post to the address: National Employment Service, Kralja Milutina 8, 11000 Belgrade, or by hand delivery to the NES Registry Office.

Untimely, undisguised, incorrectly marked and incomplete tenders shall not be considered.

The period of validity of tenders shall be at least 90 days following the tender opening day. Tenders with several possible bids are not allowed.

5. Tenders will be opened April 19, 2019. at 1.15pm in the premises of the Contracting Authority, at the address Kralja Milutina 8, 11000 Belgrade.

Attending representatives of the tenderers, if they are not directors or majority owners, shall present their credentials for participation in the tender opening session to the Contracting Authority's committee.

Prior to proceeding with tender opening, the committee shall request to see identification documents of all attending representatives of tenderers and other attending persons in order to verify their identities.

6. The award criterion shall be the most economically favourable bid.

Lot 1 – Landline telephone, internet and data transmission services

The bidder must offer all the requested services, in accordance with the Specification of the subject of the public procurement and other provisions of the tender documentation.

The evaluation and ranking of submitted bids is based on the total sum of points for the following elements of criterion:

Price per minute (local calls)	15
Price per minute (long-distance calls)	10
Price per minute (calls to mobile networks)	15

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Total monthly subscription for data transmission service (for all sites specified by the Contracting Authority in the Public Procurement Specification)	20
Total monthly subscription for direct internet access as specified in the tender documentation, for all sites specified by the Contracting Authority in the Public Procurement Specification	20
Total monthly subscription for the Webhosting service as specified in the tender documentation, for all sites specified by the Contracting Authority in the Public Procurement Specification	5
Total monthly subscription for value-added services (Call Centre) as specified in the tender documentation	5
Deadline for providing all conditions and commencement of the provision of the services in accordance with the Specification of the subject of the public procurement	10
Total number of weights (points):	100

A detailed description of criterion elements and weighting methodology for both lots is given in the tender documentation.

In the scoring and ranking of bids, the commission of the contracting authority shall take into account the offered prices with possible discounts on the offered price indicated by the bidder in the Bid form, under the conditions stated in the Bid Form.

The total number of points (weightings) for each bid is obtained in the sum of the points (weightings) that the offer carries on the basis of all eight of the above mentioned criterion elements.

In the event that two or more bidders have the same total number of points (weights), the contract will be awarded to the bidder who offers a shorter period for providing all the conditions and starting with the provision of the services in accordance with the Specification of the subject of the public procurement item.

Lot 2 – Mobile telephone services

The bidder must offer all the requested services, in accordance with the Specification of the subject of the public procurement and other provisions of the tender documentation.

The evaluation and ranking of submitted bids is based on the total sum of points for the following elements of criterion:

Price per second of local calls within the operator's own mobile network, outside of the Contracting Authority's business network	30
Price per second of domestic calls to other mobile networks	30
Price per second of domestic calls to the landline network	20



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Domestic SMS, outside of the Contracting Authority's business network	15
Monthly subscription per mobile number	5
Total number of weights (points):	100

A detailed description of criterion elements and weighting methodology for both lots is given in the tender documentation.

In the scoring and ranking of bids, the commission of the contracting authority shall take into account the offered prices with possible discounts on the offered price indicated by the bidder in the Bid form, under the conditions stated in the Bid Form.

The total number of points (weightings) for each bid is obtained in the sum of the points (weightings) which the offer carries on the basis of all five of the above criterion elements.

In the event that two or more bidders have the same total number of points (weightings), the contract will be awarded to the bidder who offers a lower price per second of local calls within the operator's own mobile network, outside of the Contracting Authority's business network. In the event that two or more bidders offer the same price per second of local calls within the operator's own mobile network, outside of the Contracting Authority's business network, the contract will be awarded to a bidder offering a lower price per second of domestic calls to other mobile networks.

In the event that the bidders are equal in all the above mentioned reserve elements of the criterion, the contract will be awarded to the bidder who offers a higher amount of the budget for the delivery of free devices (mobile phones).

7. Deadline for the decision on contract award shall be 25 days following the tender opening session.

The deadline from the previous paragraph, in cases specified by the Law, may be extended by the Contracting Authority to a maximum of 40 days following the tender opening session.

The Contracting Authority reserves the right to terminate the public procurement procedure if none of the tenders fulfils the conditions and requirements specified in the tender documentation, or for any other justified reason, as provided for in the Law.

The contract under this public procurement procedure shall be presented to the successful tenderer within 8 days from the expiry of the deadline for appeals, as envisaged in Article 149 of the Law, except in the case where Article 112, Para. 2, Item 5) of the Law is applied (where only one tender is submitted, the contract may be concluded before the expiry of the deadline for appeals).

The envisaged date of contract conclusion is in April 2019.

Upon completion of the public procurement procedure, the contract shall be concluded for a maximum period of 36 months (3 years).

The deadline for publication of the notice of concluded contract on public procurement shall be 5 days following contract conclusion.



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8. Interested parties may send a request to the Contracting Authority, in written form to the address: National Employment Service, Kralja Milutina 8, 11000 Belgrade, or by fax or e-mail, for additional information or clarifications regarding the preparation of the tender. In doing so, the interested party may also indicate any identified errors or irregularities in the tender documentation to the Contracting Authority, at the latest five days before the expiry of the deadline for submission, while the Contracting Authority shall publish the answers within the deadline and in the manner as prescribed by the Law.
